Standing room only for Tim La France, President and CEO of Terra Grain fuels at Canadian Western Agribition. Terra was asked to make two presentations by event organizers as they believed that one would not be enough. They were partly right as one was definitely not enough and neither were two. It was estimated that as many as four presentations may still not have been enough. Producers lined up for the first presentation and then again for the second. Terra staff took names of those who could not get into the venue and assured them they would be contacted after Agribition and be given personal presentations.

Tim's presentation touched on more than just Ethanol and Terra. He talked about the future of farming and how important "Value Added Processing" such as Ethanol, Bio Fuels and Canola Crushing plants were to that future.

The presentation detailed the importance of the support and involvement of Producers in all facets of "Value Added" in order for them to better control their destiny. Terra's "Grow With Us" program speaks to many of the issues facing Producers today. Terra's program offers the ability for Producers to "Deal Direct" with no middle men. "Deliver Direct" with no elevation and arbitrary freight charges. "Guaranteed Sales" with volume contracts. "Scheduled Deliveries" without someone else deciding when and if cars would be available. "Cash on Delivery" full payments without having to wait months. "Guaranteed Price" with two year fixed price contracts. "Conexus Cash Advance" incentive of \$75.00 an acre to help Producers with cash flow and to allow them to take advantage of early payment offers from input providers.

Terra Grain Fuels is currently building North America's largest Wheat Ethanol Plant at Belle Plaine, SK.. It will be commissioning in November, 07 with full production beginning in December, 07.
